## **EXTRAORDINARY SUPERHUMAN ACTIVITIES**

Businesses can engage with visitors during the week leading up to CulpeperCon (March 14-21, 2025) in two key ways at your own location with free fandom activities using a single 4"x9" activity card.

#### Activity - \$25 per business name

★ Create & host a FREE activity for the public related to comic books, graphic novels, science fiction, or fantasy.

Example: Scavenger hunt to find a comic character or fantasy element.

- ★ Visitors earn a sticker for each activity to earn prizes at CulpeperCon.
- ★ The Activity Card side features the business name, logo, QR code, & instructions for how the visitor can participate.

## Back-of-Card Promo(s) - proceeds may vary

★ Back-of-Card Promo displays your promotion with either a percent or dollar-to-sale promotion(s).

Example: A restaurant offers Superhero Spaghetti for \$10 with \$2 donated to the Friends of the Culpeper County Library from each plate sold.

★ Lists participating businesses with name, logo, & address.

Participants do NOT earn stickers with Back-of-Card Promo activities.
